

IPEV VALUATION GUIDELINES

(Online training)



The focus of this training course is on understanding and applying the International Private Equity and Venture Capital Valuation Guidelines. The emphasis will be on practical examples, discussion of case studies and day-to-day challenges in adopting the guidelines. There will be particular attention to the distinctions for both venture capital and buyout firms.

The course is suitable to anyone involved in valuation and reporting in the private equity and venture capital industry, including financial officers from private equity firms, funds of funds or service providers.
